£750,000 re-development for Hothorpe Hall

Hothorpe Hall, situated in the heart of the Midlands, between Market Harborough and Lutterworth, is investing £750,000 this winter to renovate further areas of the old Manor House venue. Work on Theddingworth's family-run event centre began on 28th November and will see two new private meeting/dining/function suites, three extra en suite bedrooms (including a plush new suite), a new reception area, an outdoor games pavilion and improved car parking.

Renovation work will mean an increase to 55 en suite bedrooms and 10 meeting rooms - including 2 adjoining private meeting/dining suites - which will add to areas already upgraded over the past five years.

Chief Executive and part-owner, Brian Dunning, said: "The latest developments will not only further improve existing parts of Hothorpe Hall, but will see unused areas redeveloped to become fantastic new areas for clients and the local community to meet, eat or party. New areas will be developed to a high standard hopefully leading to them being in high demand amongst existing and new clients. Since taking over Hothorpe in 1984 and becoming part of the local community, we've invested a lot of time, money and soul to bring it to its current high standard; however, these are the most exciting developments to date – with more yet to come!"

Hothorpe Hall is a multi-use centre that balances a mix of meetings from corporate and not-for-profit sector clients, functions, group breaks and weddings. It is easily accessible due to its location near the M6/A14/M1 motorway network and mainline train station in Market Harborough.

Work is due to be completed in March 2012 and bookings are already being taken so new areas can be utilised as soon as they are ready. Hothorpe Hall's booking team can be contacted on 01858 881502.
